
IMPORTANT: CHANGES TO YOUR COMPANY'S BUPA COVER

We have made a change to the terms of the Bupa health insurance cover which is effective from 1 January 2015 and will apply to members from the first renewal date on or after 1 January 2015. The change is detailed below.

Scale of cover

We have removed all references to 'scale of cover' from the membership guide and your employees' membership certificates.

Private hospitals charge Bupa a single rate for accommodation and your organisation's Bupa scheme offers cover for a single level of hospital accommodation. This is cover for the cost of a single en-suite room in a private hospital. For those employees' with Participating facility access, this has been known as 'Scale C' scale of cover since January 2014. However, as there is now only a single level of hospital accommodation available to all members, the term 'scale of cover' no longer needs to be used in the membership documents.

Other benefits under the scheme are not impacted by this change and your employees' will continue to have the same cover for treatment and care at the Bupa recognised facilities previously covered under your organisation's Bupa health insurance scheme.
